### **Alison Young and Keith Rothfus Sign on as Campaign Finance Chairs**

HARRISBURG, PA – The Brobson for Supreme Court Committee announced today former Congressman Keith Rothfus and conservative political analyst and consultant Alison Young will serve as Finance Co-Chairs for the campaign, providing statewide fundraising leadership and organization for the campaign.

“This election for PA Supreme Court matters, and electing Judge Brobson justice will make sure we have a strict constructionist, conservative voice on the bench,” said Young. “I am proud to support Judge Brobson and grateful for the opportunity to play a critical role in his campaign. This is not just about encouraging financial support throughout the state, but also about engaging more women to invest either a dollar or vote to build a better future for all Pennsylvanians.”

“Judge Brobson has the experience on the bench and the experience in life that we need on the PA Supreme Court,” said Rothfus. “I am going to give his campaign my all because he has that great combination of a track record on constitutional issues and the right understanding of the proper role of the judiciary in our system. He also has a life story that we can appreciate and the professional respect of the lawyers who have practiced in his court.”

Alison Young is the managing partner of Red, White and Blue Strategies (RWB) and founder of RWB’s executive coaching and leadership training practice group. She is a regular on-air commentator for 6ABC’s *Inside Story* (Philadelphia) and BBC America. Young is on the faculty of The Campaign School at Yale and previously served in leadership roles at Drexel University and the National Constitution Center. Prior to that, she served as a special assistant to President George W. Bush and as acting director of the White House Office of USA Freedom Corps.

Keith Rothfus represented Pennsylvania’s Twelfth Congressional District in Western PA between 2013 and 2019. He served on the House Financial Services and Judiciary Committees. Prior to entering Congress, Mr. Rothfus practiced law in Pittsburgh. He also previously held a

position in the Department of Homeland Security during President George W. Bush's administration. He is a graduate of the Notre Dame Law School and the State University of New York College at Buffalo.

"I am grateful for Alison and Keith's belief in me and our campaign," said Brobson. "We set out to give Pennsylvanians a new voice and a new perspective on the PA Supreme Court and with their help, we will be able to take that message to the voters."

Brobson is endorsed by the Republican Party of Pennsylvania and Pennsylvania Pro-Life Federation. He also earned a "Highly Recommended" rating from The Pennsylvania Bar Association Judicial Evaluation Commission. Raised in Lycoming County, he is the son of a retired Pennsylvania state trooper and grandson of a former Philadelphia police officer. Brobson was elected to the Commonwealth Court in 2009, retained in 2019, and chosen by his colleagues in December 2020 to serve as the 10<sup>th</sup> president judge of the Commonwealth Court.
